

### THE WILLIAM AND MARYSE TRAPNELL SCHOLARSHIP

# for Rising Juniors in French & Francophone Studies

The Trapnell Scholarship rewards the efforts of academically distinguished French majors with demonstrated financial need. To the extent possible, the Trapnell Scholarship is intended to fully pay all tuition, room and board, fees, books, and university-required electronic equipment for each student recipient. The scholarship funds may also be used for an academic semester or year of study abroad in a rigorous university program recognized by the French & Francophone Studies program. The scholarship covers all these expenses for the student's junior and senior years.

### Eligibility Requirements:

Deadline: 5pm on Friday, March 7, 2025.

- Candidates must be rising juniors (the scholarship will be applied to the Trapnell Scholar's junior & senior years)
- Candidates must demonstrate academic merit and already be the recipient of Financial Aid
- Candidates must be French majors, and preferably not be native speakers of French
- For AY 2025-26 and 2026-27 candidates must be in-state students.

To apply for the Trapnell Scholarship, submit this completed form along with the documents detailed at the bottom of this page. Include a copy of your transcript (an unofficial printout is fine). Please combine all texts into one single .pdf file; the video file can be submitted separately, but within the same email.
