

<u>Dress to Impress (D2I)</u> Policy Agreement

We're happy to assist you by providing you with an opportunity to borrow professional attire for interviews, networking events, and other career-related opportunities. Due to generous donations by alumni, faculty, staff, and fellow William & Mary students, the only fee associated with this resource is a dry-cleaning charge to ensure the borrowed items are clean once they are returned. Please carefully read the policies outlined below to ensure you can make full and appropriate use of this resource.

Eligibility

The Dress to Impress (D2I) program is available to current undergraduates, graduate Arts and Sciences, and School of Education students.

Borrow and Return Policy

All D2I items are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Borrowers are limited to one complete outfit. Clothing must be returned to the Career Center on or before the date indicated on this form and specified in your confirmation email. All suits and accessories must be returned in the same condition as received: dry-cleaned and free of odors, stains, or damages, with dry-cleaning receipt attached. Damaged, uncleaned, lost, or returned items without an attached dry-cleaning receipt are subject to fees applied directly to your student account (see "Late Returns or Damaged Items" for details). Nearby dry-cleaning options include:

Late Returns or Damaged Items

Any Dress to Impress items you borrow must be returned by the date agreed upon (no later than 10 days following your event, unless approved by a Cohen staff member) and indicated below in this form. Late returns will result in a daily fee of \$25 for the inconvenience this causes other students. Dress to Impress attire is property of William & Mary; if a suit or clothing item is lost or damaged, the borrower will be charged a replacement fee to their student account. Returned stained and/or odorous suits are subject to a cleaning fee. Please note the following fees:
