The creation of the National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC) Garden raises the visibility of historically Black fraternities and sororities at William & Mary and celebrates their contributions to our campus community — past, present and future.

NPHC organizations have been at the forefront of social, civic and community issues on an international scale. The garden will serve as a visible representation of NPHC organizations on campus, relaying history and acknowledging rich traditions. We need your help to raise \$380,000 to bring this site to life. The garden will be located along the east edge of the sidewalk that cuts across the Crim Dell Meadow, connecting the Sunken Garden to James Blair Drive and the Sadler Center. A pedestal and plaque will note each organization's name and crest, the W&M chapter name and the charter date.
