



Chart ENR 1.2 Undergraduate Enrollment Trend by Student Population 2008-2023







Chart ENR 2.1 Fall Enrollment Trend by Gender: 2008-2023




Chart ENR 2.2 Fall Enrollment Trend by Residency: 2008-2023


